LONDON SYMPHONIA EXPLORES THE NEW SOUND OF MUSIC AT METROPOLITAN UNITED



A QUESTION OF BALANCE: FROM MOZART TO STRAVINSKY Saturday, November 19 at 7:30 p.m.

LONDON, November 9, 2022 – London Symphonia's upcoming concert, *A Question of Balance: From Mozart to Stravinsky* (Saturday, November 19 at Metropolitan United) is a jewel music lovers will not want to miss.

"We are very excited to continue our exploration of the new sound of music at Metropolitan United," said Andrew Chung, Artistic Producer of London Symphonia. "The hall itself becomes an instrument. With the new renovations, the acoustics on stage have improved substantially.

"Each time we play, we have a wonderful opportunity to hear and feel how this stage enhances our performances. Every London Symphonia concert program will explore a different genre of music with a different sized ensemble, selected from across 400 years of orchestral music."

A Question of Balance showcases the London Symphonia Winds, which includes some of Canada's finest performers, in this more intimate chamber music program led by London Symphonia's own Scott Harrison.

The program explores how Mozart inspired Stravinsky. The superb London Symphonia Winds will perform Mozart's *Gran Partita*, a technically demanding work that as a result is rarely heard in live performance. Regarded by many as some of the finest music ever composed by Mozart,



the *Gran Partita* inspired Stravinsky to compose his *Octet for Wind Instruments*, 150 years later. When the *Octet* made its debut in 1923, the audience was surprised: They heard Stravinsky's unmistakable musical language, but dressed in classical forms from the time of Mozart.

The 7:30 p.m. concert can be heard in person or livestreamed online. In-person tickets are \$50 regular, \$68 premium, \$50 for livestreaming per household plus fees and HST. Tickets are available online at londonsymphonia.ca/202223-season.
