LONDON, April 1, 2025 – London Symphonia is proud to present Genevieve Fisher: Thank You Music! featuring London's own Country star, Genevieve Fisher, in a wonderful evening of music that will include the premiere of her new single *Stopped Looking* and songs spanning her career from her impressive catalogue. Scott Good, London Symphonia's Composer-In-Residence, will conduct the orchestra in new orchestral arrangements of Genevieve's songs that he has created specifically for the concert. An acclaimed Country singer-songwriter, Genevieve Fisher has earned nine top 50 hits on both Billboard's BDS and Mediabase Canadian National Country Chart; seven Female Artist of the Year nominations; three number one hits on the North American Indigenous Music Countdown chart; and numerous nominations for Single of the Year and Songwriter of the Year at the Country Music Association of Ontario Music Awards.

Over the years she has developed a strong fan base. Her songs, made vivid by her remarkable voice, captivate from the first notes and immerse listeners in deeply personal emotions and experiences.

"Being born and raised in London, I'm incredibly excited to perform with London Symphonia," said Genevieve Fisher. "We've prepared an amazing program showcasing music that has shaped my career—some of my most personal songs and some fan favorites along the way. I can't wait to see everyone.

"The premiere of my new single *Stopped Looking*, co-written with my incredibly talented friends, Shantaia and Mallory Johnson, is the icing on the cake. S*topped Looking* is inspired by the moment when I met my husband in 2011. It's all about that moment when you realize you've found your person. While the song is rooted in my own experience, I want it to resonate with anyone who has that same love and connection."

London born and raised, Genevieve Fisher, has earned 9 top 50 hits on both Billboard's BDS and Mediabase Canadian National Country Chart. Genevieve has earned recognition within the Canadian Country Music scene by earning 7 Female Artist of the Year nominations, including 2023, as well as numerous nominations for Single of the Year and Songwriter of the Year at the Country Music Association of Ontario Music Awards. While still in her teens, The Canadian Country Music Association recognized Genevieve's emerging talent with her CCMA performance selection at the 2012 New Artist Showcase in Saskatoon. Her songwriting skills continue to be acknowledged by the CCMA as witnessed by her selection to perform for the prestigious Songwriters Series in 2016 and 2018. Genevieve's Indigenous background has allowed her to register 3 number 1 hits on the North American Indigenous Music Countdown chart. Genevieve has had the opportunity to perform at some of the biggest music festivals in Canada including Boots and Hearts, Havelock Jamboree, Lucknow Music In The Fields, Manitoulin Country Fest, Trackside and Indigenous Day Live. She has had, and continues to have, the privilege of writing with some of Country music's brightest songwriters including Jason Blaine, Steven Lee Olsen, Patricia Conroy, Michelle Wright, Jason Massey, Jennifer Schott and many more.
